SCAVENGING INSTRUCTIONS

August 17, 2024 at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club Organizing Authority: Fleet 1 of the Harbor 20 Class Association

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Rock Around the Bay Scavenger Hunt is open to all Harbor 20 boats. Registrants must be members in good standing with the Harbor 20 Class Association and registered for the Summer Party to be eligible to sail in this event.

The Rock Around the Bay Scavenger Hunt will begin at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club. **The Summer Party will** be hosted by Argyle and Bridget Campbell at their home at 601 Via Lido Soud, Newport Beach, starting time is 4:30 pm.

Registration for the Summer Party and Regatta must be completed online at the Harbor 20 Class Association website (www.Harbor20.org). Attending the Summer Party does not require entry in the regatta.

The Summer Party registration fee is \$60.00 per person before August 13, 2024; \$75.00 per person after August 13,2024. The Scavenger Hunt entry fee is included in the Summer Party registration fee.

SCAVENGING RULES OF SAILING

Each skipper will receive riddles that are clues to specific racing marks around Newport Harbor. Each boat will score points by submitting the correct answer to a riddle by email to Phil Thompson at philipt@just-marine.net or by text to (714) 329-1995. Each submittal should be submitted separately and must include boat number, riddle number, the answer, and a picture that verifies that the answer was observed.

A boat shall begin their scavenger hunt after the pre-event judging portion of their boat on the dock. All answers must be received by the Scavenger Committee before 1500 hours. This is not a race.

SCORING

Since the Heritage Race is not a timed race this year, anyone could win. Here are the ways you and your team can acquire additional points.

- 1 point for each adult scavenger-day participant in each boat during the hunt, limit 6 (all participants must be breathing).
- 1 point for each child (under 14) scavenger-day participant in each boat during the race, limit 3 (all participants must be breathing).
- 1 point for each live animal scavenger-day participant (all participants be live animals).
- 2 points for each scavenger day participant of an "all-girl skipper and crew."

Moreover... Page 1 of 2

- 2 points for best themed boat, TBD.
- TBD number of points for the best judges' bribe(s) (judge's discretion).
- 1 point for having signed up for the Fleet Championship prior to the Heritage Regatta.
- 2 points for having a Commodore, a Vice Commodore, or Rear Commodore (past or present) on your boat.
- 2 points to anyone who has traveled 25 miles or more.
- 1 point for bringing someone on your boat who has never sailed.
- 1 point for bringing someone on your boat who has never attended the Heritage Regatta and Summer Party.

PRIZES

Additional prizes will be awarded for the best dressed crew, best decorated boat, most family members on boat, and the youngest sailor on board. The Harbor Heritage Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat determined by the Scavenger Committee to be the winner.
